

Make or order a Green Holiday Card.

Check out the holiday postcards from the [KSE Green Shop](#). They are made out of recycled paper. They are light weight and they have no envelope. This type of card creates less pollution, uses less trees and energy.

Or

Make a holiday Postcard (no envelope) for parents or friends.

Mosaic Postcard Design

Supplies:

60 lb recycled paper card stock.

Paper cutter

Old magazines

Scissors

Pencils

Glue

Containers to collect magazine color scraps.

1 stamp per student

Cut out cards the size of post cards. (8.5 x 5.5).

On one side of the card draw a decorative line from top to bottom. On the right side draw a spot for the stamp. On the left side each student should write their own personal greeting. Collect old magazines and have the kids cut out colorful pages. Cut colors into small pieces and collect blues in one container, greens in another, yellow in another etc. This part of the project can be done for a few days throughout the day when students have spare time.

Each student should use a pencil to draw their own holiday design on the reverse side of the card. The design should be very simple i.e. a star, moon, tree, Earth, holiday symbol. Create a mosaic design by gluing on the colorful scraps from old magazines.

Glue on their choices of colors in the background and on the design.

Draw a colorful holiday design line here.

TO:

Stamp

Draw a square here to show where to place the stamp.

Place mosaic design on the reverse side of this card.

You may use the KSE logo on your card if you wish.
