*Old groundhog burrows are reused by many other wildlife species like cottontail rabbits, raccoons, foxes, river otters, eastern chipmunks, and many small mammals, snakes and birds for shelter and having babies. *Groundhogs also help loosen up (areate) soil. *They are prey (food) for coyotes, bobcats, eagles, hawks, owls and weasels. *We'd have alot more insects if it werent for groundhogs because they love to eat them!
