Grow a Kids for Saving Earth Children's Forest

Steps to creating a children's forest and pollinator place.

- 1 Ask an adult to help you find a small section of land in your backyard or near your school, church or nearby park. Get permission to plant your forest. Draw out a plan and schedule when to plant.
- 2 Contact a local naturalist to help you choose trees, plants and teach you how to plant and care for them. Then make a forest care plan to share watering and care all year.
- 3 Add a small area for a birds and bees **Pollinator Place**.
- 4 Check out the resource ideas below to obtain trees, plants and help.

- * Visit local nurseries to ask for help and donations of plants and trees.
- * Check with your local parks department for help with finding naturalists, plants and trees.
- * Contact your state Department of Natural Resources regarding trees, plants and naturalists.
- * Go to arborday.org to obtain 10 trees for \$10.
